

Removing Stains from a Leather Jacket

Act Quickly

Barone Firenze recommends acting quickly on stains to prevent them from setting permanently into the leather. Gently dab the stain with a damp cloth or soft sponge. Avoid rubbing the leather, as this could cause abrasions or damage the finish.

Use Specific Products

For persistent stains, you can use leather-specific products such as sprays or cleansing creams. These products are formulated to clean effectively without damaging the leather. Before applying any product, carefully read the manufacturer's instructions. Always test on a small hidden area of the jacket to ensure compatibility with the type of leather.

Deep Cleaning

For a more thorough cleaning, apply the leather cleaner to a soft, clean cloth, then gently clean the surface of the leather. Work in light circular motions to remove the stain without applying too much pressure. After cleaning, use a dry cloth to remove any product residue.

Avoid Harsh Substances

It is important to avoid using harsh substances such as bleach, solvents, or alcohol, as they can cause irreparable damage to the leather. These substances can dry out and discolor the leather, compromising both its look and durability.

Regular Maintenance

Proper Storage

Store in a dry, well-ventilated place, away from direct heat sources and sunlight, which can cause discoloration and dryness. Use a padded hanger to maintain the jacket's shape and cover it with a fabric garment bag to protect it from dust.

1. ACT QUICKLY



Blot gently with a damp cloth or soft sponge.

Do not rub—this may damage the leather

3. THOROUGH CLEANING



Apply product to a soft cloth

Clean with light circular motions

Dry with a clean cloth

6. PROPER STORAGE

Store in a dry, ventilated place
Avoid sunlight and heat sources

Use padded hanger and fabric cover

2. USE SPECIFIC PRODUCT



Choose spray or cleaning creams for leather.

Test first on a hidden reaa.

Always read manufacturer's instructions

4. AVOID HARSH PRODUCTS



No bleach, solvents, alcohol

They can cause discoloration and dryness

5. REGULAR MAINTENANCE



Apply leather balm, wax or lotion

Keeps natural products

Keeps leather soft and supple
